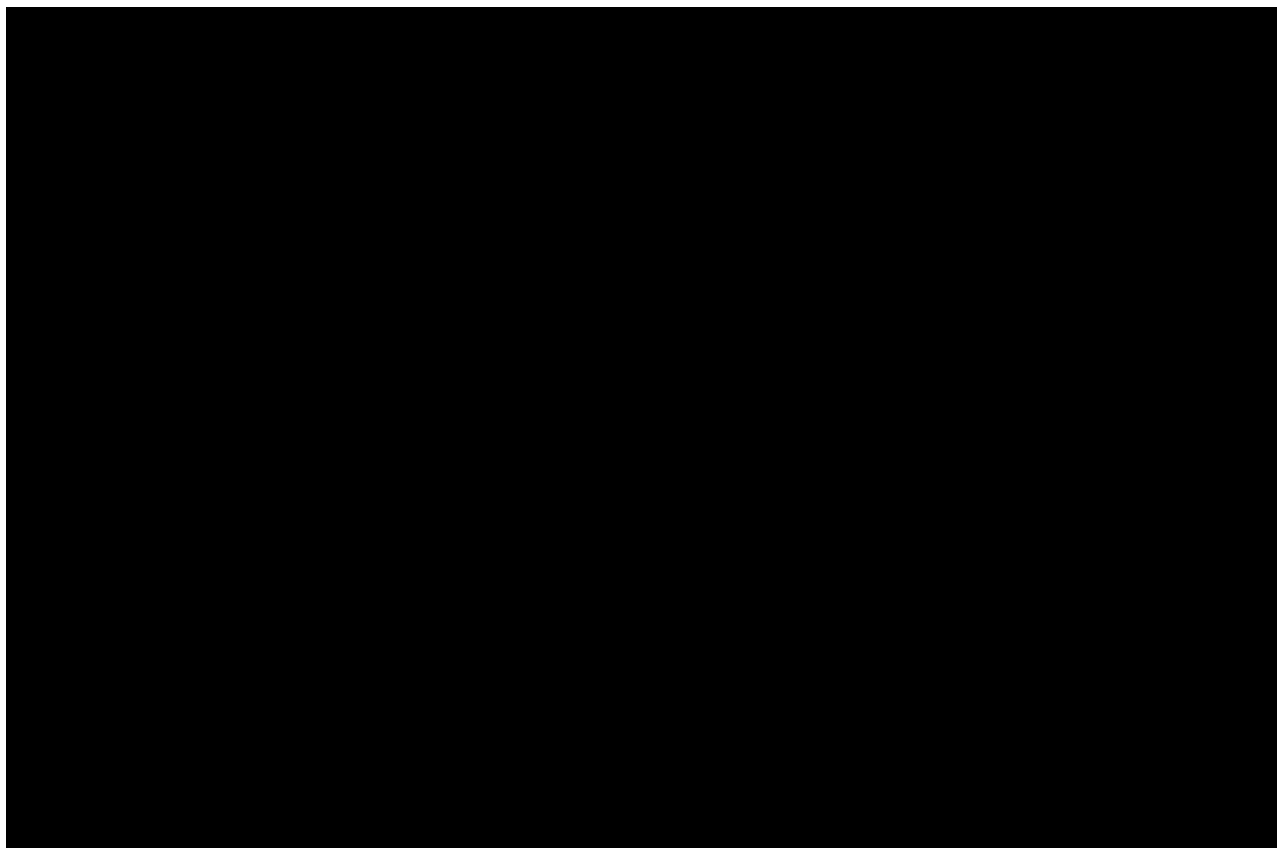


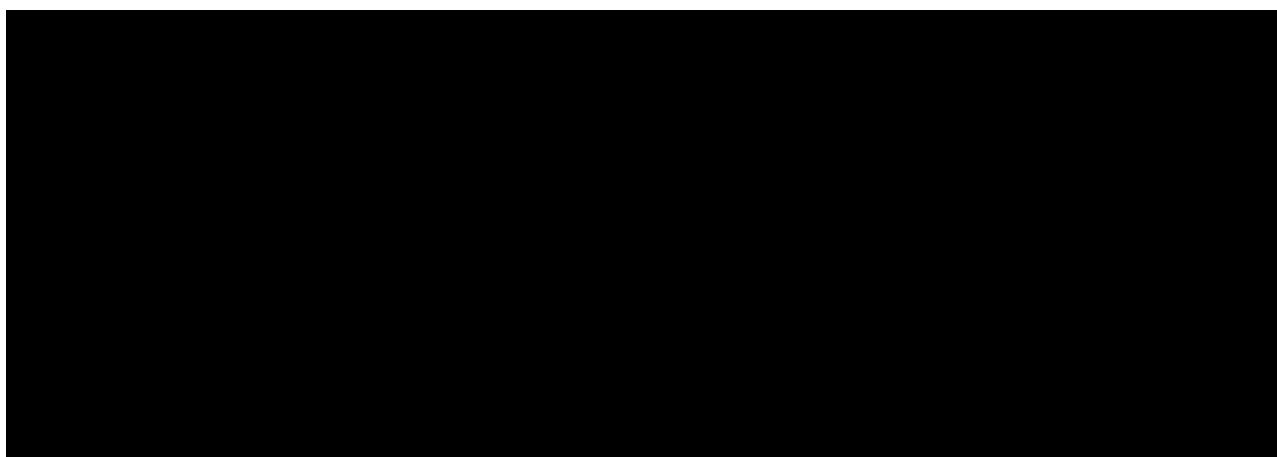
Though i don t share my incomes with anybody but here i decide to share it with you guys just to motivate you.Many of my readers on UC news are asking some questions like

Q 1. Have Good Views On UC News But Why I am Not Earning Money ?

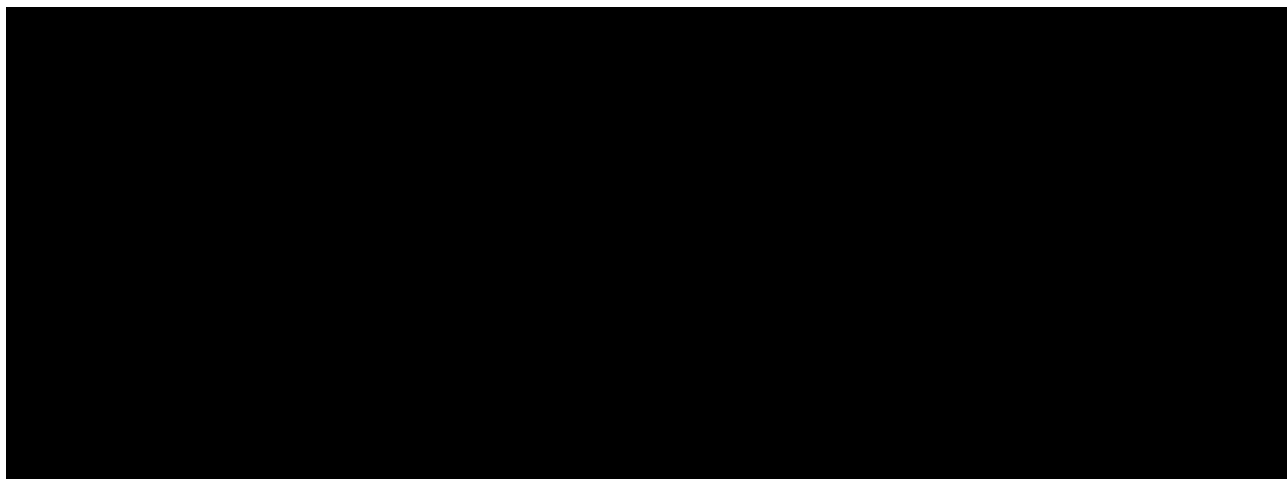
